## **MORE THAN 10 THOUSAND QUERIES SOLVED IN A DAY THROUGH THE HELPLINE**

From this control room, corona control activities are being monitored across the state including the capital. The central control room of the smart city has functioned as a war room. Since its inception, nearly 10 thousand calls have come through, in which people are getting information about symptoms, precaution and treatment to avoid corona.

High level technology and modern facilities of Bhopal Smart City Development Corporation Limited are being availed for prevention of corona epidemic. The entire city is being monitored from the Integrated Command and Control Center of Smart City. People are being made aware of covid-19 through the advertisement boards and sound system installed on the crossroads. Those who are moving out are being advised to stay in homes.



## **EMPLOYEES OF VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS UNDER ONE ROOF**

Apart from employees of Bhopal Smart City Development Corporation, staff of Health Department, Municipal Corporation and District Administration are also posted in the centralized control room. Through the call center, health department officials and experts are addressing the curiosities of the people. People are being told to follow social distancing and stay at home. In case of cold, cough, weakness and difficulty in breathing, contact the

help line and work as per the guide line of the Central Government. They are also being encouraged to wear masks and wash their hands frequently.

Chief Executive Officer of Bhopal Smart City Development Corporation Limited, Mr. Deepak Singh informed that the command and control center and ITMS of Bhopal Smart City have world-class facilities, which are being used to deal with the threat of corona virus. The staff of Bhopal Smart City is providing its services for 24 hours.

Help is being delivered to the citizens 24 hours 7 days at one click. In the last 10 days, more than 100 people sought help through the Bhopal Plus app.*

Within 24 hours, these people were assisted at home from the Corona Control Room in Bhopal Smart City. Mr. Deepak Singh, CEO of Smart City Company, is regularly reviewing the help being made through the app. Necessary directions are also being given to the concerned team. Most of the request are related to ration and demand of sensitization their houses or colonies. After prompt action on this, feedback was also taken from the call center from the applicant. and the level of satisfaction was also asked.

Only this week 51 people were helped till Friday. Frequent request on Bhopal Plus app are about , symptoms of corona, exhaust gas cylinders, need for drugs, help to those who trapped outside the city or within city, and to keep an eye on people from outside came in their locality.

### **SERVICES DIVIDED INTO THREE CATEGORIES**

Services on the Bhopal Plus App are divided into three categories. This includes emergency services, national level and district level health services, municipal corporation services. Emergency services include not having food, exhausting gas or kerosene, taking patients to hospital in an emergency, and law and order related services. Under national level and district level health services, to collect information of people whose history of travel is special.

There is also information related to corona. The services of the Municipal Corporation include sanitation, washing and cleaning of the corona virus patients' house and the surrounding area.

### **THIS IS HOW THE SERVICE WILL WORK**

Help can be taken from the Corona Help Desk after downloading the app from the Play Store. Complaints on the app will be linked to the CM Help Line and the Corona Help Desk of the Smart City Company. On receipt of complaint, the complaint will be sent to District Administration, Municipal Corporation, Health Department, Transport Department etc. for quick action from here. Along with this, the help desk toll free number 18002330014 of Bhopal Plus App can be contacted. Those who already have the Bhopal Plus app will have to go to the Play Store and update it. The app has a window of corona emergency support.



## MONITORING OF COVID-19 WITH 450 SMART CAMERAS OF BHOPAL SMART CITY

The Corona covid-19 epidemic control activities are being monitored with 450 smart cameras installed in the city by Bhopal Smart City Development Corporation Limited. These cameras are installed on the integrated traffic management system and smart poll of Bhopal Smart City. Feeding every moment from these is reaching the control room of the smart city in Govindpura, which is easing the epidemic control. This control room is working 24 hours.



## 24-HOUR MONITORING FROM SMART CITY WAR ROOM

Looking at the corona virus, there is a lock down and curfew all over the country including the capital. Roads and neighborhoods are being monitored through smart cameras of the smart city and it is seen that people are violating the lock down. If found doing this, the police are being immediately informed about it. The police is going to those places to make people stay in their homes, as well as action is being taken on the people.

CEO of Bhopal Smart City Company, Mr. Deepak Singh informed that people are being appealed through public announcement system to stay in homes and help in prevention of epidemics. Public Announcement Systems are engaged in Smart Poll of Smart City. 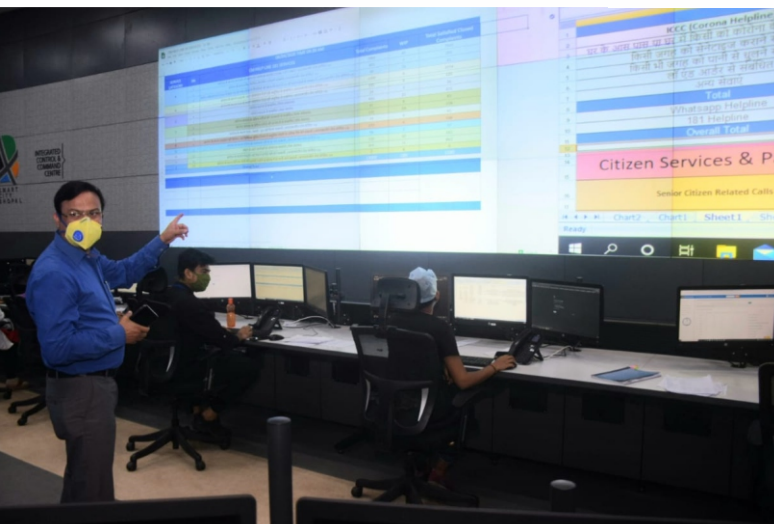
# SMART CITY CAMPUS SANITIZED

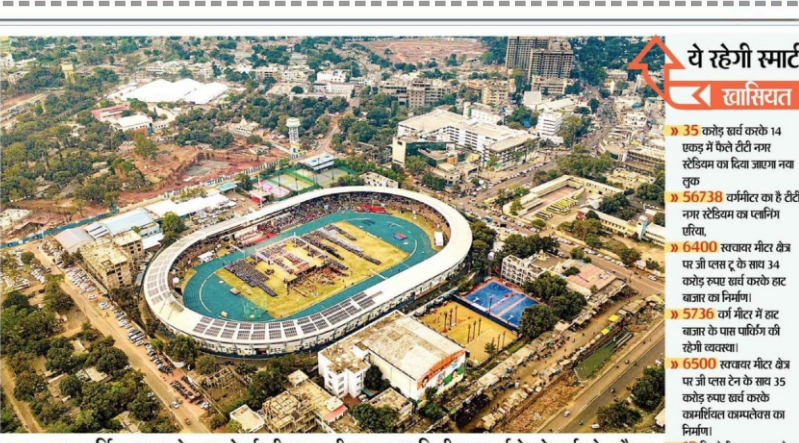

### Take a green ride as bike sharing goes electric

Bhopal: The state capital's public bike sharing (PBS) project is set to go electric. This means some 500 bicycles under PBS will be electric cycles. Pined with a battery, charging station and a helmet, the electric cycle is expected to be ready by early 2021.

The PBS project by Bhopal Smart City Development Corporation Limited (BSDCL) will be expanded to include electric cycles. There are two options being considered, according to BSDCL officials. While the first option is to provide 50 bicycles under corporate social responsibility, the second option is to convert some of 500 cycles into electric ones.

Experts are apprehensive about the stability of battery and its safety. Company officials, in a meeting with city and the cycle and other utilities are managed by PBS. #### Bhopal smart city to turn to banks, PSUs for investment

Bhopal: In a fresh push to attract much needed investment in development of 'TT Nagar smart city development', Bhopal Smart City Development Corporation Limited is reaching out to banks and other institutions. The move is a shift from the previous government's policy which sought direct private investment in smart city development.

BSDCL is aiming at financing the ambitious scheme in collaboration with banks and other agencies. BSDCL executive director P Vijay Datta said that Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd has approached the smart city limited with regards to development of areas.

"We expect to attract around Rs1,000 crore of investment in the next few months," said
